

Smart class cum Group Presentation

The department of Political Science organized a smart class cum group presentation on 21/11/2025 in Seminar Hall with the objective of enriching students' learning experience through interactive and technology-based teaching methods. The program began with a smart class conducted by Ms. Sanghamitra Dev Ray, HoD of Dept. Of Political Science who delivered an engaging session using audio-visual tools to enhance conceptual understanding.

Following the smart class, a group presentation by the students was conducted. The presentation centered on movie reviews of *Paramanu: The Story of Pokhran & Madras Cafe*. The student groups highlighted important themes, historical contexts, character portrayals and socio-political relevance depicted in the films. They analyzed the narrative techniques, real-life events connected to the stories, and how the films effectively portrayed issues of national security, intelligence operations and India's strategic development. The presentations reflected the students' research skills, critical thinking and team works.

After the presentations, Dr. Banasmita Sarma, Assistant Professor of Dept. Of Political Science offered a insightful suggestions on how a movie review should be done, stressing

the importance of clear analysis, logical structure, balance viewpoints, and proper connections between the story lines of the films and its broader socio-political contexts.
